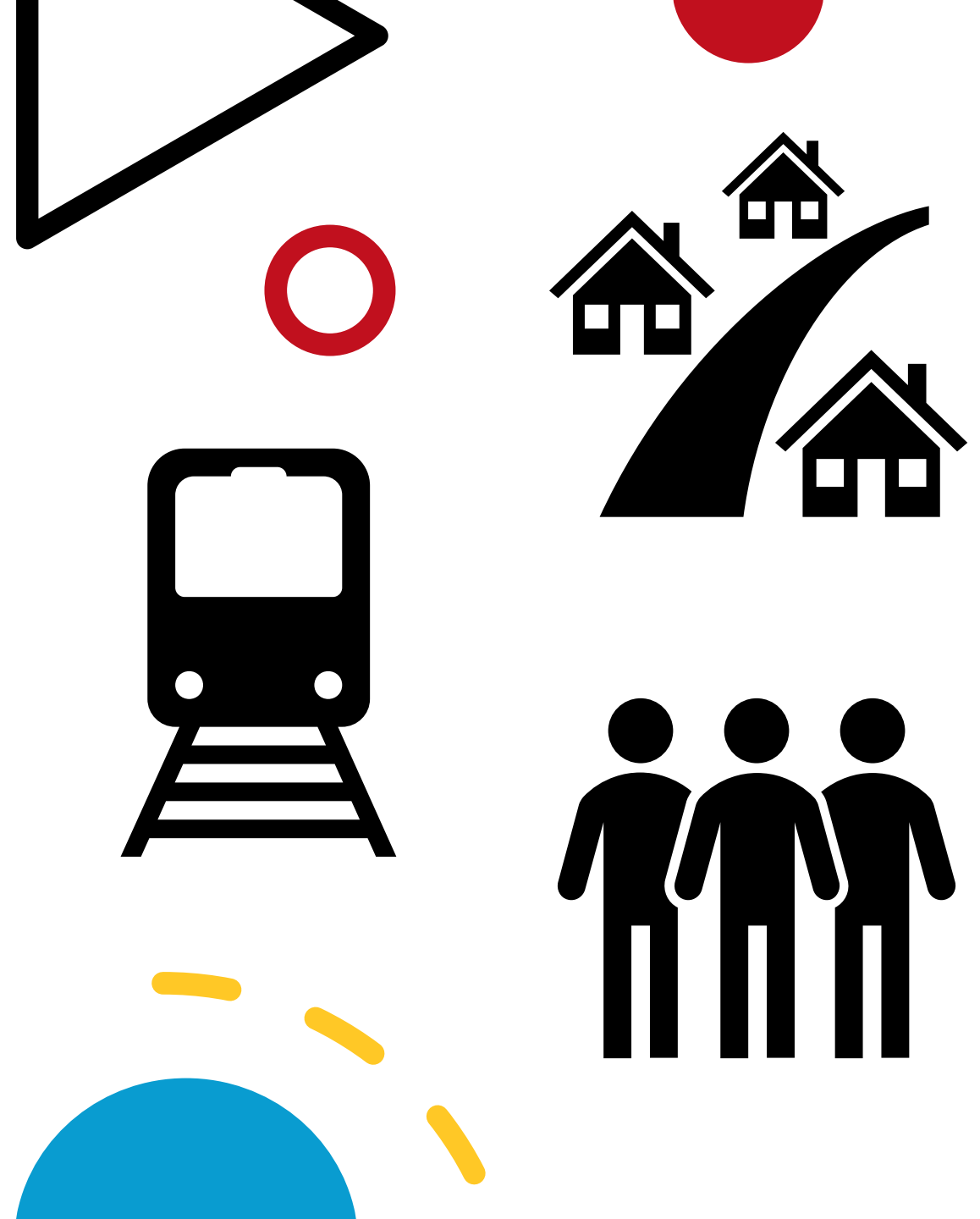

What is Tulipathon?

- Fundraiser that starts online after MHI's AGM
- MHI's single-biggest fundraiser
- All proceeds go to MHI's subsidize program which provides MHI's tenants with a little extra help on their rent
- A celebratory walk takes place halfway through the fundraiser to bring together MHI faith groups, fundraisers, and volunteers
- The walk is May 28th 2:00 PM at Commissioner's Park (Dow's Lake)
- Brings together MHI faith groups & volunteers
- Fundraising ends on June 30th



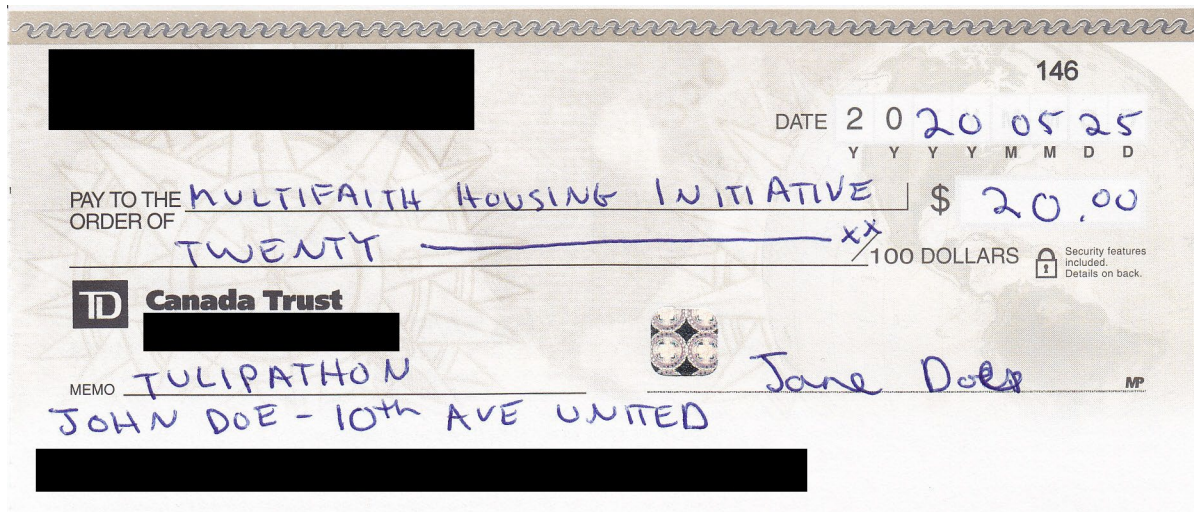
